Biography

JASMIN ŠOŠE - PROSECUTOR OF THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Jasmin Šoše was born on 11 November 1958 in Čeljevo, Čapljina municipality, where he finished his primary and secondary school.

He graduated from the Faculty of Law in Sarajevo on 28 January 1984.

He passed his bar exam in Sarajevo on 22 December 1988.

He completed his internship in the Municipal Court in Čapljina in the period between 1985 and 1987. In the period from 18 September 1989 to 1 July 1993 he performed the duties of a Revenue Administration inspector in Čapljina and of the Deputy Joint Public Attorney for the municipalities of Čapljina, Neum and Stolac. In the period from 28 January 1994 to 1 August 1996 he was a judge of the Mostar District Military Court - Konjic Department, and in the period from 1 August 1996 to 30 April 1998, he performed the duties of a judge of the High Court in Mostar. During 2002 and 2003, he worked as the Executive Director for General and Legal Affairs in "Šipad Komerc" d.d. /JSC/ Sarajevo, and then as an expert advisor in the Attorney General's Office of the Municipality of Novi Grad Sarajevo.

In the period from October 2003 to June 2021, he worked as a prosecutor in the District Public Prosecutor's Office in East Sarajevo and in the period from 1 July 2010 to 15 October 2020, he performed the duties of the Deputy Chief Prosecutor.

At the session of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina held on 19 and 20 May 2021, he was appointed Prosecutor of the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina and he took office on 13 June 2021.
