## **Biography**

### **JASMINA GAFIĆ – PROSECUTOR OF THE PROSECUTOR’S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA**

Jasmina Gafić was born in Foča, Bosnia and Herzegovina, in 1953. She graduated from the Faculty of Law, University of Sarajevo, in 1977 and passed the bar exam in 1979.

She did her internship at Sarajevo Municipal Prosecutor’s Office II, after which she worked as a lawyer in the company “Feroelektro” dd (Joint-Stock Company) Sarajevo in Sarajevo.

In the period between 1979 and 1985, she was a prosecutor at Sarajevo Municipal Prosecutor’s Office II in which she was appointed Acting Chief Prosecutor.

From 1992 to 1994 she worked as a prosecutor at Sarajevo Higher Prosecutor’s Office in (presently Cantonal Prosecutor’s Office). In February 2003, she was selected as one of the first four prosecutors of the Prosecutor’s Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina by the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina, where she has been working to this day. In 2005 she was appointed Deputy Head of the Special Department for Organised Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption by a decision of the Chief Prosecutor of the Prosecutor’s Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina and held that position four years.

She is frequently an attendee and presenter at professional seminars in the country and abroad, especially in the field of criminal prosecutions of illegal migrations and smuggling of people. She has been a member of the Association of Prosecutors of Bosnia and Herzegovina since its establishment.
