Biography

OLIVERA ĐURIĆ – PROSECUTOR OF THE PROSECUTOR’S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Olivera Đurić graduated from Sarajevo University Faculty of Law in 1983. She started working that same year as an intern in the municipal administrative bodies.

After passing a certification exam for employees of administrative bodies in 1984, she worked as an officer for property-legal affairs. In the period between 1985 and 1987, she passed an exam for a magistrate and worked in this capacity at Maglaj Municipal Misdemeanour Court, after which she became the President of the said Court and held that position until 1992.

During 2000 and 2001, she worked as an expert associate in Maglaj Municipality and at Maglaj Municipal Court. In the period between 2001 and 2003 she was a municipal attorney in Maglaj Municipality.

She passed the bar exam on 27 January 2003. From April 2003 to March 2006 she worked as a lawyer-administration specialist and Municipal Administration Reform Program Manager within the USAI-supported Administrative Law and Procedural Systems IRIS/ALPS Project.

Until December 2006, she worked as a legal officer at the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina, namely as an employee of the Registry Office supporting Department I for War Crimes and Department II for Organised Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption of the Criminal and Appellate Division of the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

By a decision of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council dated 8 November 2006, she was appointed judge at Kiseljak Municipal Court and held this position from December 2006 to February 2008, when she became the Secretary of the Prosecutor’s Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina and held this position until 1 December 2013.

She was appointed Prosecutor of the Prosecutor’s Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina by a decision of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council dated 20 November 2013 and took office on 1 December 2013.
