Biography

SENA UZUNOVIĆ – PROSECUTOR OF THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Sena Uzunović graduated from Sarajevo University Faculty of Law in 1984.

She began her professional career in 1985 as an intern at the Municipality of Hadžići – Municipal Service for Property-Legal Rights, where she worked until 1991.

In 1993 she was appointed judge of Mostar District Military Court, Konjic Department, and occupied that position until 1996, when she was appointed judge of Mostar Higher Court.

From 1998 to 2001, she worked as Deputy Minister of Finance for Legal and General Affairs in the Ministry of Finance of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, as well as an adviser for legal matters at the Office of Deputy Prime Minister of the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina. From 2001 to 2003, she performed the duties of a judge at Sarajevo Municipal Court I and in the period from 2003 to 2007 she worked as a prosecutor of the Cantonal Prosecutor's Office in Sarajevo – Department for Economic Crime and Corruption.

She was appointed prosecutor of the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina by a decision of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina in January 2007 and then Deputy Head of the Special Department for Organised Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption in early 2009.

She participated in the operation of many bodies of the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, among others, of working groups for drafting different laws at the level of the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina. In the Special Department for Organised Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption, Prosecutor Uzunović is a member of the Task Force for Countering Terrorism and a member of the Working Group for Developing a Draft Law for Countering Terrorism with the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
