Biography

SLAVICA TERZIĆ – PROSECUTOR OF THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Slavica Terzić was born in Bosanski Novi, Bosnia and Herzegovina, in 1948. She graduated from Sarajevo University Faculty of Law in 1973.

She did her internship at Sarajevo District Prosecutor's Office and, after passing the bar exam in 1975, she was elected Deputy Prosecutor of Sarajevo Municipal Prosecutor's Office II. From 1982 to 1991, she was employed as Deputy District Prosecutor at Sarajevo District Prosecutor's Office.

In the period between 1992 and 1993, she worked as an expert associate in the Diplomatic Consular Mission within the Embassy of Bosnia and Herzegovina to Slovenia and from 1996 to 1997 she worked in the Ministry for Refugees and the Ministry for Civil Affairs of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

In the period between 1997 and 2000, she worked in the Commission on Property Claims of Displaced Persons and Refugees (CRPC) and, in the period from 2000 to 2004, in the Independent Judicial Commission for Election and Appointment within the HJPC BiH.

She was appointed Prosecutor of the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina by a decision of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council in October 2004.

In 2004, she paid a professional visit to the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia (ICTY) in The Hague. She attended many seminars and vocational trainings in the field of criminal prosecution of war crimes.
