Stanko Blagić was born in Travnik, Bosnia and Herzegovina, on 24 June 1958. He graduated from Sarajevo University Faculty of Law in 1983.

He started his judicial career by working as President of Jajce Misdemeanour Court in 1994 and he performed the duties of a judge at Teslić Basic Court from 1996.

From 1999, he held the position of judge at Doboj District Court, after that he was a judge at Zenica Municipal Court from 2004 and then, from 2008, he worked as a judge of Banja Luka Basic Court until 2012 when he was appointed judge of Teslić Basic Court.

He was appointed Prosecutor of the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina by a decision of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council dated 20 November 2013.

He has been a member of the Association of Judges and Prosecutors since its foundation. During his career he, as a judge, attended many seminars for the purpose of receiving vocational training in the field of criminal justice. He is an author of publications and professional papers published in judicial bulletins.
