Pursuant to Article IV.4a) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina at the 84th session of the House of Representatives held on 29 August 2006 and the 62nd session of the House of Peoples held on 7 September 2006 adopted the following

LAW

ON ADOPTION OF THE LAW ON AMENDMENTS OF THE LAW ON THE TRANSFER OF CASES FROM THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR THE FORMER YUGOSLAVIA TO THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF BIH AND THE USE OF EVIDENCE COLLECTED BY ICTY IN PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE COURTS IN BIH

Article 1

- (1) By this Law the Law on Amendments of the Law on the Transfer of Cases by the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia to the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Use of Evidence Collected by the ICTY in the Proceedings before the Courts in Bosnia and Herzegovina, enacted on an interim basis by the High Representative for Bosnia and Herzegovina, published in the Official Gazette of BiH No. 46/06 shall be adopted.
- (2) The Law and all the supporting regulations enacted pursuant to the Law shall be applied from the day of entering into force of the Law on Amendments of the Law on the Transfer of Cases by the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia to the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Use of Evidence Collected by the ICTY in the Proceedings before the Courts in Bosnia and Herzegovina, (Official Gazette of BiH No. 46/06).

Article 2

This Law shall be published in the Official Gazette of BiH.
