Biography

DIANA KAJMAKOVIĆ – PROSECUTOR OF THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Diana Kajmaković was born in Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina, in 1966. She graduated from the Faculty of Law, University of Sarajevo, in 1990.

She began her professional career as an intern at Sarajevo Municipal Court II in 1991, worked there until March of the same year and then continued her internship at Higher Public Prosecutor's Office in Sarajevo.

After passing her bar exam in 1993, she served as an expert associate at Sarajevo Municipal Prosecutor's Office until 1995 when she started working as Deputy Municipal Prosecutor at Sarajevo Municipal Prosecutor's Office II.

In 2003 she was appointed Cantonal Prosecutor at Sarajevo Cantonal Prosecutor's Office and she was appointed prosecutor of the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina by a Decision of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina in May 2008.

She is a trainer for the Centre for Education of Judges and Prosecutors of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina. She attended several national and international conferences and seminars on fight against organised crime and corruption. During 2009, she went on a study trip to the United States the purpose of which was to improve the fight against organised crime and corruption in line with best international practices.

In the period from 2009 to 2012, she was a member of the Working Group for Drafting the Action Plan for Implementation of the Strategy for Combating Organised Crime. She also received specialist training for work in SEE Joint Investigation Teams.
