Pursuant to Article IV.4a) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina at the 58th session of the House of Representatives held on 8 June 2005 and the 43rd session of the House of Peoples held on 29 June 2005 adopted the following

LAW ON AMENDMENTS OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

The Criminal Procedure Code of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Official Gazette of BiH No. 3/03, 32/03, 36/03, 26/04 and 63/04) shall be amended as follows:

Article 1

In Article 112 (Analyses of Deoxyribonucleic Acid) the words "specialised institution"shall be replaced with the words: "institution in possession of necessary expertise in terms of staff and equipment to do a forensic DNA analysis".

Article 2

In Article 115 (Registry of DNA Analyses and Data Protection) in paragraph 1 the words "in a special registry within the competent Ministry in Bosnia and Herzegovina" shall be replaced with the words "in a special registry at the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina".

After paragraph 1 a new paragraph 2 shall be added to read as follows:

"(2) The Minister of Justice of BiH shall enact the Book of Rules on a manner of collecting and taking specimen from a biological material for the needs of a DNA analysis in the criminal procedure, the manner of packing biological material, preservation, processing and storing specimen and results of the DNA analysis in Bosnia and Herzegovina".

The former Article 2 shall become Article 3.

Article 3

This Law shall enter onto force on the eighth day from the day of its publication in the Official Gazette of BiH.
